AFFIRMATIONS:

I choose by my free will to be directed only by the Holy Spirit, and to perform and work in the new person that Jesus created me to be. I refuse to be pressured by the familiar spirits in my conscience to do what they want me to do. I refuse to operate out of my old man nature to perform or not perform through being dominated by fear or anger. I refuse to be controlled by my ancestry, or the memories of my past.

I will receive instructions from my spouse, parents, children, boss, instructor, customers, or clients and do them in the order that the Holy Spirit directs me to do them through my new person. I refuse to allow fear, anger, or resentment to control my actions and the order in which I do these instructions. I refuse to listen to familiar spirits tell me what to do.

I am a new person in Jesus Christ and all things that have controlled my actions in the past have been removed. I am directed only by the Holy Spirit and empowered in the new person by Jesus Christ, my Lord.

Affirmations based on scriptures.

Jesus has put a new person in me and I am joined to Jesus. My old nature, my ancestry, my images, my memories of the past, and my addictions have passed away, and all things have become new. Jesus has created a new person for me, has filled my spirit with himself. 2 Corinthians 5 AMP

17 Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!

Galatians 6 AMP

15 For neither is circumcision [now] of any importance, nor uncircumcision, but [only] a new creation [the result of a new birth and a new nature in Christ Jesus, the Messiah].

Ephesians 2 NKJV

15 having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace,

Romans 7 AMP

6 But now we are discharged from the Law and have terminated all intercourse with it, having died to what once restrained and held us captive. So now we serve not under [obedience to] the old code of written regulations, but [under obedience to the promptings] of the Spirit in newness [of life].

Colossians 3 AMP

10 And have clothed yourselves with the new [spiritual self], which is [ever in the process of being] renewed and remolded into [fuller and more perfect knowledge upon] knowledge after the image (the likeness) of Him Who created it.

Romans 6 AMP

4 We were buried therefore with Him by the baptism into death, so that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious [power] of the Father, so we too might [habitually] live and behave in newness of life.

1 John 2

27 But as for you, the anointing (the sacred appointment, the unction) which you received from Him abides permanently] in you; [so] then you have no need that anyone should instruct you. But just as His anointing teaches you concerning everything and is true and is no falsehood, so you must abide in (live in, never depart from) Him [being rooted in Him, knit to Him], just as [His anointing] has taught you [to do].
