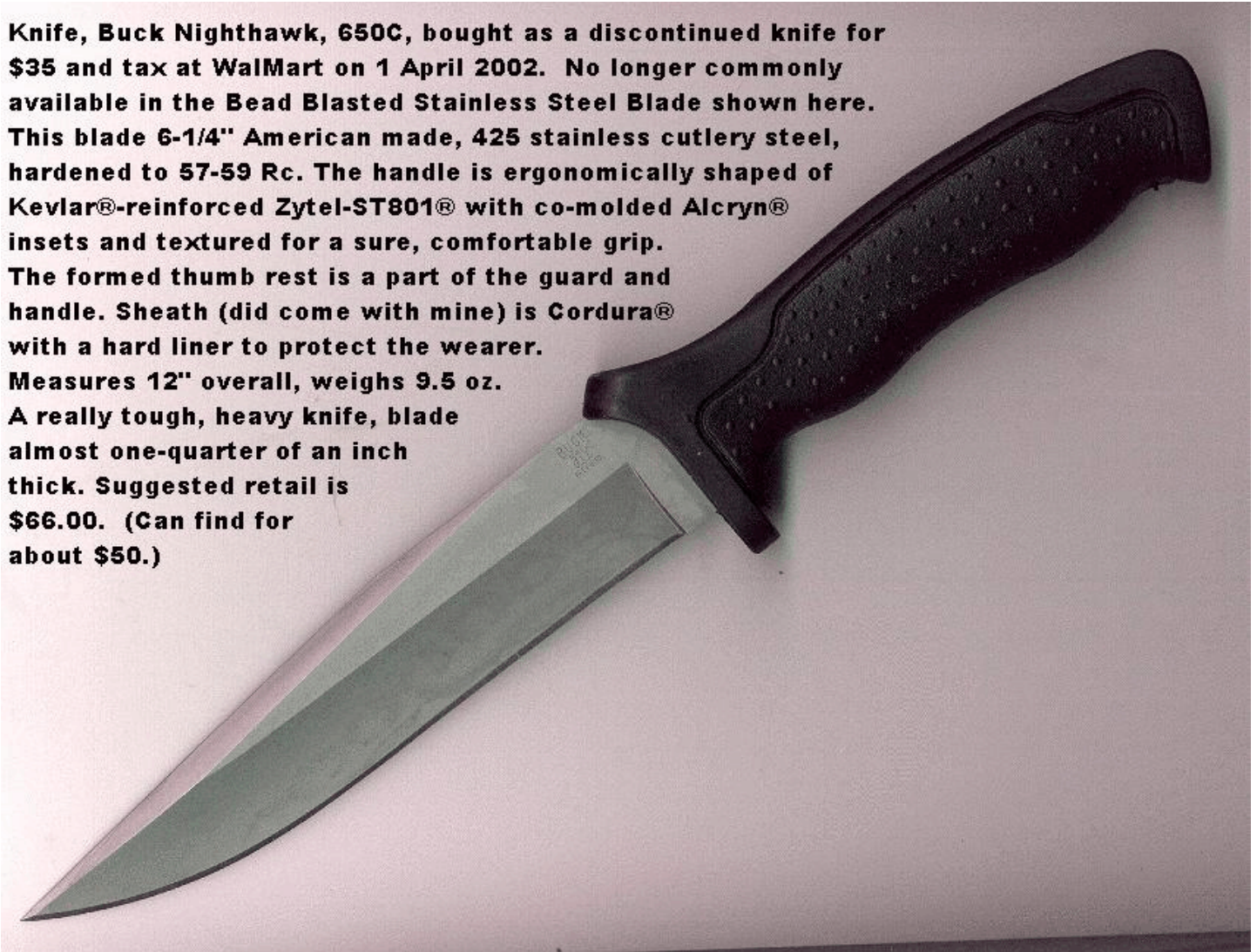


The Following Picture, on the next page, prints on my printer life-size. It is a picture of a Buck 650C Nighthawk Hunting Knife. It is included as a pattern for a knife maker. The over-all length is eleven-and-on-quarter inches.

Knife, Buck Nighthawk, 650C, bought as a discontinued knife for \$35 and tax at WalMart on 1 April 2002. No longer commonly available in the Bead Blasted Stainless Steel Blade shown here. This blade 6-1/4" American made, 425 stainless cutlery steel, hardened to 57-59 Rc. The handle is ergonomically shaped of Kevlar®-reinforced Zytel-ST801® with co-molded Alcryn® insets and textured for a sure, comfortable grip. The formed thumb rest is a part of the guard and handle. Sheath (did come with mine) is Cordura® with a hard liner to protect the wearer. Measures 12" overall, weighs 9.5 oz. A really tough, heavy knife, blade almost one-quarter of an inch thick. Suggested retail is \$66.00. (Can find for about \$50.)
